College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Mid-Continent honors as a junior. A member of the Puerto Rican U21 National Team.

Redshirt Senior (2005-06): Averaged 8.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, and 3.8 assists. Scored in double figures 13 times. Recorded season-high 25 points at Oakland. Tallied 15 points and seven assists at IUPUI. Scored 16 points and dished out four assists at Oral Roberts. Registered ten points and a season-high eight assists vs. Indiana-South Bend.

Senior (2004-05): Granted a medical redshirt after missing all but two games of the season due to a foot injury. Posted seven points and seven assists in the season opener at Cincinnati. Scored nine points at Central Michigan.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 11.3 points, 3.3 rebounds, and 6.0 assists. Ranked second in the conference in assists. Posted career-high 28 points vs. Oral Roberts. Recorded 21 points, ten assists, and five steals vs. Southern Utah. Registered 14 points and 11 rebounds at IUPUI. Posted a double-double of 12 points and ten assists at Marquette. Averaged 15.7 points and 7.3 assists in the Mid-Continent Tournament, earning All-Tournament honors.

Sophomore (2002-03): Averaged 7.6 points, 2.6 rebounds, and 4.7 assists. Ranked third in the conference in assists and second in steals (57). Started all 31 games. Scored in double figures nine times. Posted a season-high 13 points, five assists, and four steals at IUPUI. Recorded 12 points and six assists at UMKC. Dished out a season-high nine assists at Chicago State. Scored 13 points at Iowa in the first round of the post-season NIT.

Freshman (2001-02): Averaged 4.4 points, 1.7 rebounds, and 1.9 assists in 14.0 minutes a contest. Posted four double-digit scoring efforts. Scored season-high 15 points vs. Oakland. Recorded 13 points and five rebounds vs. Goshen.
