**Pro Career Highlights:** Played with the DMU Leicester City Riders in England in 2005-06. Averaged 12.2 points, 3.7 rebounds, 1.4 assists, 1.8 steals, and 1.3 blocked shots in 39 games.

**College Highlights:** A two-year starter who carved out a role as a versatile defender. Started 63 of 130 career games. Scored in double figures six times, with three times occurring in the NCAA Tournament.

**Senior (2004-05):** Averaged 3.8 points and 3.3 rebounds in 23.9 minutes a contest. Ranked third on the team in assists and steals. Started 29 of 32 games. Scored in double figures twice. Tallied a career-high-matching 13 points, seven rebounds, and three blocked shots vs. Virginia. Posted ten points, three rebounds, four assists, three blocked shots, and three steals vs. James Madison. Scored nine points and blocked a career-high-matching four shots vs. Air Force. Matched a career-high by grabbing five steals vs. Duke. Scored ten points on a perfect 4-for-4 shooting vs. George Washington in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Junior (2003-04):** Averaged 3.4 points and 3.2 rebounds in 18.3 minutes a contest. Started 32 of 38 games. Scored nine points and grabbed five rebounds in an early season win over Tennessee State. Tallied five points, four assists, and a career-high five steals vs. Marist. Pulled down a career-high eight rebounds vs. Virginia Commonwealth. Tallied seven points and six rebounds vs. Duke. Set a season-high of ten points vs. Northern Iowa in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Matched season high by registering ten points vs. Boston College in the second round. Posted six points, seven rebounds, four assists, and three steals vs. Oklahoma State in the Final Four.

**Sophomore (2002-03):** Averaged 2.0 points and 1.3 rebounds in 11.1 minutes a contest. Registered season highs in points (seven), rebounds (six), and assists (five) in the season opener vs. Arkansas-Pine Bluff. Matched season high in scoring with seven points vs. Tulane. Recorded six points and five rebounds vs. Duke.

**Freshman (2001-02):** Averaged 1.8 points and 1.3 rebounds in 9.4 minutes a contest. Started twice. Posted career-high 13 points on 5-for-7 shooting vs. Cornell.
