## Pro Career Highlights:

**College Highlights:** Finished collegiate career as Belmont's all-time leader in assists (452) and steals (178). Ranks fifth all-time in the school's Division I history with 1,199 career points. Scored in double figures 65 times. Started 103 of 119 career games.

**Senior (2005-06):** Averaged 10.8 points, 4.4 rebounds, and 4.4 assists in 26.5 minutes a contest. Set a school single season record for assists (136). Started all 31 games. Posted a season-high 21 points and a career-high seven steals vs. Lipscomb. Scored 18 points on 7-for-8 shooting vs. Gardner-Webb. Tallied 14 points, eight assists, and five rebounds at Campbell. Scored 20 points and dished out six assists vs. East Tennessee State. Notched a 12-point, season-high ten-rebound double-double vs. Lipscomb. Registered 14 points and seven assists vs. Campbell in the Atlantic Sun Tournament quarterfinals. Recorded ten points and seven rebounds vs. Lipscomb in the tournament finals. Scored seven points vs. UCLA in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Junior (2004-05):** Averaged 10.6 points, 4.6 rebounds, and 3.4 assists (ranking tenth in the Atlantic Sun) in 28.1 minutes a contest. Led team in assists and total rebounds. Started all 30 games. Scored in double figures 17 times, topping the twenty-point mark twice. Scored a season-high 20 points vs. UC Riverside and at Florida Atlantic. Tallied 17 points, seven rebounds, and four assists vs. Mercer. Posted 16 points and seven rebounds vs. Lipscomb. Scored 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. Central Florida in the Atlantic Sun Tournament semifinals.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** Averaged 10.3 points and 4.2 rebounds in 29.6 minutes a contest. Led the team in assists and ranked second in rebounding. Started 22 of 29 games. Scored in double figures 16 times, including 12 of his final 16 games. Shot 9-for-14 from the field in scoring a career-high 23 points at Jacksonville. Posted first career double-double with 13 points and ten assists at Campbell. Scored ten points and grabbed a career-high nine rebounds vs. Troy. Tallied 17 points and seven rebounds vs. Mercer. Scored ten points vs. Vanderbilt in the season opener.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Averaged 8.6 points and 3.2 rebounds in 26.3 minutes a contest. Started the final 20 games of the season. Posted season-high 17 points at Mercer. Tallied 15 points and a season-high seven rebounds vs. Georgia State. Dished out a season-high seven assists twice, vs. East Tennessee State and at Campbell. Scored 11 points vs. Georgia. Recorded 14 points and four assists at Valparaiso. Earned Atlantic Sun All-Freshman Team honors.
