**Pro Career Highlights:** Played briefly in Spain in 2005-06, appearing in six games with Granada and averaging 9.7 points and 3.2 rebounds. Made his NBA debut with the New Orleans Hornets in 2004-05, playing in ten games and averaging 2.7 points and 2.5 rebounds. Spent the majority of the year with the Sioux Falls Skyforce in the CBA, averaging 17.9 points and 9.9 rebounds. Helped the Skyforce to a CBA championship and earned Playoff MVP honors. Also played in Turkey in 2004-05, playing in ten games with Fenerbahce Istanbul and averaging 12.5 points and 7.1 rebounds. In 2003-04, played with Gloria Due Montecatini in the Italian Legadue, averaging 16.1 points and 9.3 rebounds in 38 games. Split time between the CBA and Italy in 2002-03. With the Yakima Sun Kings and Sioux Falls Skyforce in the CBA, averaged 14.0 points and 6.6 rebounds. Also played with Carife Ferrara in the Italian Legadue, appearing in five games and averaging 15.4 points and 8.4 rebounds. Selected by the Sacramento Kings in the second round (#58 pick overall) of 2002 NBA Draft. An early entry candidate for the 2001 NBA Draft, but withdrew his name from consideration.

**College Highlights:** Named Northeast Conference Player of the Year as a senior. Earned First Team All-Conference honors his junior and senior seasons. Finished collegiate career as Central Connecticut State's second all-time leading scorer (1,731 points) and fifth all-time leading rebounder (967 rebounds). Recorded 31 career double-doubles. Sat out the 1997-98 season at Central Connecticut State as a partial qualifier.

**Senior (2001-02):** Averaged 15.4 points and 8.7 rebounds. Started all 32 games. Posted eight double-doubles. Registered 25 points and 17 rebounds vs. Bucknell. Scored 25 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. Farleigh Dickinson. Pulled down a career-high 19 rebounds vs. Bucknell.

**Junior (2000-01):** Led team in scoring (16.2 ppg) and rebounding (7.9 rpg). Also ranked second on the team in field goal percentage (.524) and blocked shots (35). Started 23 of 28 games. Registered six double-doubles. Posted career-high 36 points and grabbed 17 rebounds vs. Maryland-Baltimore County. Tallied 30 points, nine rebounds, and six steals vs. Seton Hall.

**Sophomore (1999-00):** Averaged 12.2 points and 7.5 rebounds. Led the team in blocked shots (62). Posted ten double-doubles. Scored a season-high 19 points vs. Farleigh Dickinson.

**Freshman (1998-99):** Averaged 12.7 points and a team-high 7.4 rebounds. Registered seven double-doubles. Recorded a season-high 24 points vs. St. Francis. Named to the Northeast Conference All-Newcomer Team.
