Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA summer league with the Miami Heat in the summer of 2006. Played in China during the 2005-06 season with the Shandong Jinsidun Lions (statistics unavailable).

College Highlights: Earned Third Team All-Southland Conference honors as a sophomore and was named Honorable Mention All-Conference as a senior. Finished collegiate career as Sam Houston State's all-time leading shot-blocker with 267. Holds the school's top four single season marks for blocked shots. Also eighth all-time in rebounds with 618. Redshirted the 2003-04 season while recovering from knee surgery.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 9.0 points, 6.9 rebounds (ranked fifth in the SLC), and a league-leading 2.3 blocked shots in 22.0 minutes a contest. Started 28 of 30 games. Scored in double figures 13 times. Posted five double-doubles. Registered season-high 21 points and grabbed seven rebounds at Texas-Pan American. Tallied 13 points, seven rebounds, and a season-high seven blocked shots vs. Binghamton. Set a season-high with 15 rebounds in the season opener vs. Houston. Posted 16 points, 13 rebounds, and six blocked shots vs. Arkansas State. Notched 20 points and 15 rebounds vs. McNeese State.

Junior (2002-03): Averaged 7.2 points and 5.5 rebounds in 18.3 minutes a contest. Led the Southland Conference in blocked shots (2.7 bpg). Started nine of 29 games. Scored in double figures in seven games. Posted career-high 22 points vs. Nicholls State. Registered a double-double of 14 points and ten rebounds vs. Texas-Dallas. Scored 17 points and grabbed seven rebounds at Lamar. Set a school single game record with eight blocks vs. Lamar. Earned Southland Tournament All-Tournament honors after recording 20 points, 11 rebounds, and four blocked shots in two games. Recorded ten points and 11 rebounds vs. Florida in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore (2001-02): Averaged 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 15.2 minutes a contest. Ranked fourth in the league in blocked shots (5.4). Played in 28 games and started 17 times, including ten of the last 11 games of the season. Scored in double figures three times. Recorded season highs of 13 points and 14 rebounds and added five blocked shots vs. Texas-Arlington. Tallied 12 points, eight rebounds, and four blocked shots vs. Texas State. Scored 12 points and blocked a season-high six shots vs. Nicholls State.

Freshman (2000-01): Averaged 6.1 points and 4.9 rebounds in 19.2 minutes a contest. Ranked third in the league in blocked shots (2.3 bpg). Played all 29 games and started 16 times, including the last 12 games of the season. Posted a double-double of 15 points and ten rebounds vs. Texas-Arlington. Scored 14 points at Northwestern State. Tallied 12 points and four rebounds at Stephen F. Austin.
