**College Highlights:** Named Second Team All-MIAA honors and was named to the conference All-Defensive Team as a senior. Earned West Most Outstanding Player honors at the NABC NCAA Division II All-Star game after scoring 18 points and a team-high 11 rebounds. Finished collegiate career at Southwest Baptist University in Bolivar, Missouri after spending first three seasons at Oklahoma State. Sat out the 2001-02 season at Oklahoma State as a partial qualifier. Participated in the 2006 NBA Pre-Draft Camp.

**Senior (2005-06):** Averaged 12.4 points (ranked 14<sup>th</sup> in the MIAA) and a team-high 7.8 rebounds (third). Led the conference in blocked shots (2.1 bpg). Scored 20 or more points three times. Posted ten double-doubles. Registered career highs of 24 points and 15 rebounds vs. Truman State. Scored 11 points and grabbed 14 rebounds at Northwest Missouri State. Tallied 23 points and nine rebounds vs. the College of the Ozarks. Recorded 22 points and ten rebounds vs. Pittsburg State in the first round of the MIAA Tournament. Grabbed a team-high 14 rebounds vs. Northwest Missouri State.

**Junior (2004-05):** At Oklahoma State, averaged 2.7 points and 1.4 rebounds in 6.5 minutes a contest. Played in 18 games and started four times. Scored in double figures twice. Registered a season-high 15 points on 5-for-7 shooting vs. Washington State. Scored 11 points, grabbed three rebounds, and snared three steals vs. Arkansas-Little Rock. Recorded nine points, a season-high five assists, and two blocked shots in the season opener vs. Northwestern State.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** Averaged 1.6 points and 1.6 rebounds in 7.3 minutes a contest. Played in 14 games and started once. Scored a season-high six points on a perfect 3-for-3 shooting vs. Texas-San Antonio. Pulled down a season-high four rebounds vs. Southeastern State. Tallied four points and three rebounds vs. Northwestern State in the season opener.

**Freshman (2002-03):** Averaged 0.5 points and 1.2 rebounds in 5.6 minutes a contest. Appeared in 20 games. Scored a season-high three points vs. Arkansas. Tallied two points and two rebounds vs. Colorado. Recorded three rebounds and two blocked shots vs. Hartford. Posted two points and three rebounds at Alaska-Anchorage.
