College Highlights: Earned First Team All-Big Sky honors as a senior. Finished collegiate career at Sacramento State after playing first two seasons at Massachusetts. Sat out the 2002-03 season at Sacramento State under NCAA transfer rules. Was the runner-up at ESPN's College Slam Dunk Championship in 2005.

Senior (2004-05): Averaged 15.0 points (ranked fifth in the Big Sky) and 4.4 rebounds. Ranked third in the conference in three-point field goals made per game (2.36), fourth in three-point field goal percentage (.378), and seventh in steals (1.4 spg). Missed three games due to a stress fracture in his right foot. Set a school Division I record by scoring a career-high 40 points vs. William Jessup. Also tied the school record for three-point field goals made in a game (8). Scored 25 points vs. Southern Utah. Tallied 24 points and a season-high nine rebounds vs. Eastern Washington. Posted 25 points and seven rebounds vs. Montana and recorded 26 points and six rebounds in the next game vs. Montana State.

Junior (2003-04): Averaged 9.3 points and 4.9 rebounds in 19.5 minutes a contest. Started 11 of 28 games. Scored in double figures nine times, with a season-high 24 points at Montana State. Scored 22 points at Northern Arizona. Posted 18 points in the season opener vs. Stanford. Narrowly missed a double-double with nine points and a season-high 11 rebounds vs. Weber State. Tallied 14 points and seven rebounds at San Jose State.

Sophomore (2001-02): At Massachusetts, averaged 5.3 points and 2.1 rebounds in 11.4 minutes a contest. Played in 12 games. Posted season-high 22 points at Fordham. Tallied 12 points and six rebounds vs. Maine. Contributed 11 points and five rebounds at Central Connecticut State.

Freshman (2000-01): Averaged 1.2 points and 0.8 rebounds in 2.6 minutes a contest. Appeared in 17 games. Posted season-high seven points and grabbed four rebounds vs. Connecticut in his collegiate debut. Scored three points and grabbed a season-high five rebounds vs. North Carolina.
