Pro Career Highlights: Played with the Nebraska Cranes in the USBL in the summer of 2006, averaging 15.9 points and 4.6 rebounds in 29 games. Helped the Cranes to a USBL championship and earned First Team All-League honors. Spent the 2005-06 season with the San Jose Skyrockets in the ABA (statistics unavailable). Earned Honorable Mention All-League honors and made an appearance in the ABA All-Star game. Played with the Arkansas Angels in the WBA in 2005, averaging 14.5 points and 4.8 rebounds in four games. Spent the 2002 season in Venezuela with Trotamundos de Carabobo and Panteras de Miranda. Started pro career in Iceland with Keflavik in 1999-00, averaging 23.1 points in eight games.

College Highlights: Finished collegiate career as the 14th all-time leading scorer in Ole Miss history with 1,286 points. Also finished as the school's all-time leader in steals (211). Posted eight career double-doubles. Started 103 of 118 career games.

Senior (1998-99): Averaged 12.9 points and 5.6 rebounds. Led the team in rebounding and ranked second in scoring and assist. Started 32 of 33 games. Paced the team in scoring eight times, including five of the last seven games of the season. Set a career-high with 24 points vs. Alabama. Posted 20 points vs. LSU. Registered 20 points at Mississippi State. Tallied 19 points and five rebounds at Vanderbilt. Matched career highs with 24 points and 14 rebounds vs. South Carolina in the first round of the SEC Tournament. Scored 18 points vs. Michigan State in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Junior (1997-98): Averaged 9.8 points and 6.5 rebounds. Led the team and ranked seventh in the SEC in steals (1.7 spg). Started 28 of 29 games. Scored in double figures 15 times. Registered three consecutive double-doubles against Louisiana Tech, Temple, and Arkansas-Pine Bluff to open the season. Grabbed a career-high seven steals vs. Florida. Scored 20 points and pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds vs. South Carolina in the SEC Tournament.

Sophomore (1996-97): Averaged 11.4 points and 5.8 rebounds. Led the team in field goal percentage (.542), ranked third in scoring and second in rebounding. Started all 29 games. Scored in double figures 15 times and led the team in scoring five times. Set a career-high with 24 points vs. Mississippi State. Registered a 18-point, 11-rebound double-double vs. Alabama, and recorded a 15-point, 11-rebound double-double in the rematch. Scored 17 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. Appalachian State. Posted 12 points and a team-high seven rebounds vs. Temple in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (1995-96): Averaged 9.2 points and 4.9 rebounds. Led the team in field goal percentage (.527). Started 14 of 27 games, including 13 of the last 14 games of the season. Scored in double figures 13 times and led the team in scoring twice. Posted a 16-point, ten-rebound double-double vs. Auburn. Tallied 15 points, six rebounds, and two blocked shots vs. Florida. Scored 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds vs. Houston Baptist. Registered 14 points and seven rebounds at Alabama. Scored 18 points on 8-for-13 shooting vs. Florida in the SEC Tournament.
