**College Highlights:** Started 86 of 94 career games at Ohio State. Finished collegiate career at Ohio State after playing freshman season at Arkansas. Sat out the 2002-03 season under NCAA transfer rules.

**Senior (2005-06):** Averaged 10.1 points and 7.0 rebounds. Was one of five players on the team to average double figures in scoring. Started 31 of 32 games. Matched a career-high with 24 points vs. Florida A&M. Tallied 23 points, ten rebounds, four assists, and three steals vs. Belmont. Pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds vs. Butler. Registered 14 points and nine rebounds vs. Virginia Tech. Posted a 19-point, 13-rebound double-double vs. Indiana in the semi-finals of the Big Ten Tournament. Scored 13 points and grabbed 13 rebounds vs. Davidson in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

**Junior (2004-05):** Averaged 9.7 points and 5.4 rebounds. Started all 32 games. Scored in double figures 15 times, with a season-high 21 points vs. Chattanooga. Recorded 16 points and seven rebounds vs. Creighton. Grabbed a season-high 11 rebounds vs. Minnesota. Posted 17 points and six rebounds vs. Indiana. Tallied 15 points, eight rebounds, and four assists at Northwestern. Earned All-Tournament Team honors at the Guardians Classic.

**Sophomore (2003-04):** Averaged 10.1 points and 4.6 rebounds. Started 23 times. Led the team in scoring 16 times. Registered career-high 24 points in the season opener at San Francisco. Posted 22 points vs. Virginia Tech. Recorded first career double-double with 22 points and season-high 11 rebounds vs. Virginia Tech. Tallied 18 points and six rebounds in the first round of the Big Ten Tournament vs. Indiana.

**Freshman (2001-02):** At Arkansas, averaged 9.4 points and 3.0 rebounds in 21.2 minutes a contest. Ranked third on the team in scoring. Started 12 times. Scored in double figures 15 times, with a season-high 20 points vs. Oklahoma State. Tallied 19 points and six rebounds at Memphis.

**Personal:** Graduated with a degree in African American and African Studies. Father, James, played collegiately at Oberlin College.
