Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA summer league with the Chicago Bulls in the summer of 2006.

College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Horizon League honors as a senior. Started 64 of 90 career games at Illinois-Chicago. Finished collegiate career at Illinois-Chicago after playing first season at Maryland-Eastern Shore. Sat out the 2002-03 season under NCAA transfer rules.

Senior (2005-06): Led team in scoring (14.7 ppg), steals (1.3 spg) and field goal percentage (.524) while ranking second on the team in rebounding (6.8 rpg) and free throw percentage (.781). Ranked in the Top Ten in the Horizon League in all five categories. Started 30 of 31 games. Scored 20 or more points six times. Posted seven double-doubles. Registered career-high 26 points and 13 rebounds vs. Cleveland State. Matched career high with 26 points and added ten rebounds vs. Wisconsin-Green Bay. Posted 22 points and 11 rebounds at Northwestern. Scored 21 points and grabbed 11 rebounds at Syracuse. Earned All-Tournament Team honors at the BP Top of the World Classic after averaging 14.3 points and 7.3 rebounds.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 7.8 points and 5.4 rebounds in 23.9 minutes a contest. Led the team in blocked shots (12). Started 17 times. Scored in double figures 11 times, with a career-high of 18 points twice, vs. South Dakota State and Georgia Southern. Posted a 15-point, 11-rebound double-double vs. Saginaw Valley State. Scored 15 points and grabbed eight rebounds at Cleveland State. Registered 12 points on 6-for-8 shooting vs. Loyola (Ill.) in the Horizon League Tournament.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 4.2 points and 2.9 rebounds in 15.6 minutes a contest. Started 15 times. Recorded season-high 13 points, four rebounds, and three assists vs. Youngstown State. Tallied nine points and a season-high seven rebounds vs. Butler in the Horizon League Tournament semifinals. Scored eight points vs. Kansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Freshman (2001-02): At Maryland-Eastern Shore, averaged 7.4 point and 5.2 rebounds. Ranked second on the team in rebounding and blocked shots. Earned MEAC All-Rookie Team honors.
