Pro Career Highlights: Selected by the Colorado 14ers in the 8th round of the 2006 NBA Development League Expansion Draft. Finished the 2005-06 season in the NBA D-League with the Fayetteville Patriots. Appeared in 12 games, averaging 8.7 points and 5.1 rebounds. Started the year with Club River Plate Buenos Aires in Argentina, averaging 11.8 points and 5.8 rebounds in 25 games. In 2004-05, started the season in China with the Shangdong Jinsidun Lions, averaging 3.3 points and 3.0 rebounds in six games. Moved on to the Italian Legadue with Cimberio Aironi Novara, averaging 10.4 points and 7.8 rebounds in 17 games. Participated in NBA training camp with the Denver Nuggets in the fall of 2003, moving on to play with the Columbus Riverdragons in the NBA D-League in 2003-04, averaging 10.4 points and 6.2 rebounds in 46 games. Spent the 2002-03 season in the NBA Developmental League with the Greenville Groove. Started 44 of 47 games and averaged 9.6 points and 6.4 rebounds. Tied for the team lead in blocked shots, ranked second in rebounding, and ranked fourth in scoring. Selected by the Greenville Groove in the first round (#8 pick overall) of the 2002 NBA Developmental League Draft.

College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Atlantic 10 honors as a junior. Finished four-year career as third player in Temple history to record 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in a career. Ranks second in school history in blocked shots with 219. A four year starter who started 128 of 133 career games.

Senior (2001-02): Averaged 8.6 points, 7.8 rebounds, and 1.3 blocked shots. Started 31 of 32 games. Ranked fifth in the A-10 in rebounding and eighth in blocked shots. Posted five double-doubles, while scoring in double figures 14 times. Grabbed a season-high of 15 rebounds twice, at Massachusetts and vs. St. Bonaventure. Tallied 13 points and 10 rebounds vs. eventual champion Maryland. Registered season-high 19 points and seven rebounds vs. La Salle. Snared 14 rebounds at St. Joseph's.

Junior (2000-01): Averaged 12.8 points, 8.9 rebounds, and 2.0 blocked shots. Started 34 of 36 games. Led team in rebounding and blocked shots, and ranked third in scoring. Led nation in offensive rebounds at 4.1 offensive boards a game. Scored over 20 points on four occasions. Led team in rebounding in 17 games. Posted a 22 point, 15 rebound double-double vs. Cleveland State. Had a 16 point, 15 rebound double-double effort at St. Joseph's. Recorded season-high 27 points at Fordham. Played all 40 minutes nine times. Named to the Atlantic-10 All-Tournament Team and the NCAA South Regional All-Tournament Team.

Sophomore (1999-00): Averaged 6.4 points, 7.6 rebounds, and 1.6 blocked shots. Started 29 of 31 games. Ranked fifth in the conference in rebounding, second in blocks. Registered six double-figure rebounding games. Scored 15 points vs. Massachusetts in the semi-finals of the A-10 Tournament. Tallied 11 rebounds and five blocked shots in the title game vs. St. Bonaventure. Grabbed 11 rebounds and blocked career-high eight shots at Florida State.

Freshman (1998-99): Averaged 7.4 points, 5.9 rebounds, and 1.6 blocked shots. Started all 34 games. Led team in blocks and finished second in rebounding. Posted three double-doubles. Pulled down 11 rebounds at Rhode Island. Averaged 11.0 points and 7.7 rebounds in the Atlantic-10 Tournament. Recorded 14 points and eight rebounds vs. Purdue in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.
