Pro Career Highlights: Participated in NBA training camp with the Washington Wizards in the fall of 2006. An early entry candidate for the 2005 NBA Draft before withdrawing his name from consideration.

College Highlights: Earned Second Team All-Atlantic 10 honors his junior and senior seasons. Named to the conference All-Defensive Team as a senior. Led team in rebounding all four seasons. Finished collegiate career as George Washington's 12th all-time leading scorer with 1,216 points.

Senior (2005-06): Averaged 11.0 points and 7.6 rebounds (ranked fourth in the A-10). Started all 30 games. Posted nine double-doubles. Scored career-high 22 points on 10-for-12 shooting and pulled down ten rebounds vs. Kennesaw State in the season opener. Tallied 14 points, a season-high 12 rebounds, three assists, and two steals vs. Maryland. Hit a career-high five threes in scoring 18 points at Xavier. Recorded 17 points, ten rebounds, five assists, and four steals vs. St. Joseph's. Registered 13 points and ten rebounds in the first round of the NCAA Tournament vs. UNC-Wilmington. Scored 13 points and grabbed six rebounds vs. Duke in the second round.

Junior (2004-05): Averaged 10.6 points and 8.0 rebounds. Started 21 of 28 games. Recorded seven double-doubles. Registered season-high 19 points, nine rebounds, and a season-high five assists at Duquesne. Posted ten points and ten rebounds at Wake Forest in the season opener. Grabbed a career-high 17 rebounds vs. La Salle. Tallied 11 points, 14 rebounds, and four assists vs. Richmond. Matched season-high with 19 points and pulled down ten rebounds at Dayton. Scored 13 points and grabbed nine rebounds vs. Georgia Tech in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

Sophomore (2003-04): Averaged 10.3 points and 7.8 rebounds. Started all 30 games. Registered five double-doubles. Recorded a season-high 19 points and grabbed 12 rebounds vs. Duquesne. Scored a team-high 15 points and grabbed eight rebounds vs. Richmond. Posted 17 points and ten rebounds vs. La Salle.

Freshman (2002-03): Averaged 9.7 points and 8.2 rebounds (ranked second in the A-10). Started all 29 games. Posted four double-doubles. Tallied 12 points and nine rebounds at Connecticut. Recorded ten points and 13 rebounds vs. Maryland. Scored 16 points and grabbed 13 rebounds vs. Bucknell for his first career double-double. Registered season-high 19 points vs. Massachusetts in the Atlantic-10 Tournament. Named to the Atlantic-10 All-Rookie Team.
